Step Three: Get your flu shot (ouch - but well worth it!)

If you follow these three simple steps, Primary Health will donate \$5 to Boise High Girls and Boys Basketball. I know what you're thinking ... what's the catch, right? There literally is no catch. Most private insurers cover the cost for flu shots so they are either free or are typically a nominal fee. Our program will receive that \$5 kickback on everyone who presents the card with the exception of folks who are on Medicare or Medicaid.
