Stay Healthy by Getting Your Flu Shot @ Primary Health!

This program is very simple and can be a win-win for all involved.

Step One: Pick up one of the Brave Basketball Primary Health postcards connected to the flu shot program. These will be readily available in the Roosevelt Main Office and on hand at most upcoming events.

Step Two: Take your Brave Basketball Primary Health postcard to any Primary Health location in the Treasure Valley and give that card to the folks when you arrive to get your flu shot.

Step Three: Get your flu shot (ouch - but well worth it!) If you follow these three simple steps, Primary Health will donate \$5 to Boise High Girls and Boys Basketball. I know what you're thinking ... what's the catch, right? There literally is no catch. Most private insurers cover the cost for flu shots so they are either free or are typically a nominal fee. Our program will receive that \$5 kickback on everyone who presents the card with the exception of folks who are on Medicare or Medicaid.
