EXTRA! EXTRA!

- ✓ **Safe Routes** - As we approach the shorter days of winter we need to make sure our children are wearing proper safety gear as they commute to and from school. Lisa Brady, from Safe Routes to School, visited our children during PE class last week and spoke to them on how to safely commute to and from school, on bike and on foot.

Here are some safety tips she's provided:

1. Wear brighter colors, carry a flashlight and use reflectors so drivers can see you better in the darker parts of the day.
2. Remember, it's harder to see everyone in the rainy time of the year, look twice before you move.
3. Clip on reflectors, arm bands or pant straps help add visibility.
4. Always use the crosswalk to cross and remember to STOP, look left, right, left AND in front and behind you before crossing the street.
5. Communicate your actions whether making eye contact with drivers or using hand signals on your bike.
6. Be predictable: Ride on the right side of the road and in a straight line where drivers can see you. Slow down on the sideWALK!
7. Lights on your bike: Not just a good idea, it's the law. White light in the front, red light in the rear. Spoke reflectors are great!
8. Finally, doing all of these things are great, but choosing a route that is well lit, has safe crossings and less traffic is a good idea too.

**Parents, if you tell your child they must wear a helmet, YOU must also wear a helmet. Children learn good behavior by your good example. A student told us during our recent visit to Roosevelt that their mom doesn't wear a helmet because she knows how to ride a bike. Unfortunately, you may very well know how to ride, but you cannot control what others are doing around you. If you have a crash with your child and hit your head, you may not be able to care for or even survive to help your child in the crash. **
