### **Why should we donate, you ask?**

Well, it is simple. Boise has great schools but they need our help.

Donating to this cause will help ensure our kids continue to receive the excellent quality education that they have been getting in the Boise school system but in safer, modern schools. All four of our traditional high schools are on The Washington Post list of the top 9% of high schools in the country but the condition of our schools does not reflect the excellent education and programs taking place inside. Aging, overcrowded and outdated schools pose a real threat to educational quality and safety.

### **Here are the facts!**

This bond will reinvest in every neighborhood school without raising the tax rate  
Given the overcrowding in our schools, there are 144 portables currently in use across the District  
    Nearly half of our schools were built before 1960  
    Obsolete electrical systems cannot support modern technology  
    Security, fire alarms and fire suppressions systems are seriously outdated  
    Lowell receives maintenance dollars after the 2010 remodel from the last bond  
    Washington receives a historic, complete remodel  
    Longfellow receives a new cafeteria, and additional PE, performing arts and classroom space  
    Roosevelt receives a new dedicated space for PE, performing arts and cafeteria

### What would happen if it doesn't pass?

The District will have to look at many different solutions including possible boundary changes and program locations to address overcrowding; portables will continue to be used and critical repairs will be made only as funds become available in the general budget
