As we heard from the distinguished speakers, its time for Idaho to take action to address the impacts from climate change and to deal with the root causes. We also heard about how, earlier in the session, the House and Senate Education Committees voted to amend Idaho's K-12 science education standards by omitting references to climate change and human impacts on the environment.

Tomorrow, April 18th, you have a chance to correct that, by letting the State Department of Education know that Idaho's children deserve robust, comprehensive science standards! I encourage you to attend the public hearing in Boise at 6 p.m.
